

Measure 4: Ability of completers to be hired in education positions for which they have been prepared

Introduction

The evidence provides current employment milestone data for advanced program completers working in NC Public Schools.

Data Description:

The data presented below is a snapshot of ECU EPP graduates currently employed in NC public schools. This data is published on the NC Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) Employment Tracker Dashboard and is current as of 4/11/2023. The dashboard is updated by NCDPI and made available to Educator Preparation Programs through a secure site. Employment data is obtained from district payroll and budget information and merged with Title II and EPP reports for completers. Employment data is not linked to the NC Teacher License system.

Data Notes:


- Employee counts by type are not unique, as some roles may be held concurrently.
- There are also several notable limitations including that completers will not be included in the file if the license was not applied for and made effective within one year of graduation date. Other data limitations include possible errors in Title II and EPP completer reporting or district budget codes that do not align with position (i.e., Superintendents).
