# Housekeeping

- 1. Minutes were approved for last MLS Curriculum Committee.
- 2. Dr. Soulen will chair the MLS Curriculum Committee for AY 2021-22
- 3. Committee goals for AY 2021-22.

### The MLS 2021-2022 Curriculum committee will:

- Continue discussion of a seminar on health sciences librarianship.
- Plan next curriculum workshop to include 6048, 6991, 6992 (the remaining core courses).
- Revise the public library concentration to remove 6133/6135/6137 as required courses.
- Consider for AY 2022-23 the possibility of redeveloping LIBS 6170 The Adult Reader.
  - Faculty who may wish to teach this course would need to access a syllabus, and make considerable revisions.
- Develop a Curriculog package for the adjusting prerequisites and co-requisites for a number of courses.
- Consider adding the archives course as a permanent course (elective).

## **Old Business**

- 1. The MLS faculty voted to approve moving forward with removal of LIBS 6133/6135/or 6137 as a required course for the Public Library concentration at the February 25, 2021 program meeting. The MLS Curriculum Committee will initiate this in Curriculog. This change will likely not be ready to implement until Fall 2022.
  - 1.1. Action Item: Dr. Soulen will bring this forward to IDP for a vote
- 2. Dr. Bright will develop a package reflecting changes to pre-requisites, recommended pre-requisites, and co-requisites to submit in Curriculog.
  - 2.1. **Action Item:** Revise the narrative justification for the package (see document in Teams).
  - 2.2. Question: 6137 appears in both packages, should it have its own package?
