

Partnership Teach **MIDDLE GRADES EDUCATION** Model

REQUIREMENTS:

Minimum GPA	2.5
Prerequisite Course Requirement	Completion of all Community College courses is recommended, but may have 4 or fewer courses at the end of Spring term (EDU 216 & EDU 279 are exceptions)
Praxis Core Exam	Passing score 468 (state required) by Upper Division application. <i>Preference may be given to applicants who have already attempted or who are registered for the exam.</i>
ECU Course Schedule	Approximately 3 classes (7-10 hrs.)/semester until internship.
Practicum Requirements	Varies but usually ranges from 12-40 hrs./semester in a NC public school.
Internship Requirements	Internship I: 1 day/wk. for 1 semester & Internship II: 5 days/wk for 1 semester
Recommended For	Working adults and/or students with multiple obligations outside of school.
ECU Plan of Study	3 years
Starting Term	Fall (August)
