The General Curriculum (GC) program prepares students to work with children with disabilities who are ultimately pursuing a high school diploma and are studying in the general education curriculum. The courses in this program provide a common core of general knowledge and skills necessary for beginning teachers. Candidates in the SPED GC program complete reading and mathematics courses to support students in the general education curriculum. Under current requirements, students in the GC major may be eligible to add on an elementary education license by exam.

The Adapted Curriculum (AC) program prepares students to work with children with more significant cognitive disabilities who are pursuing an adapted curriculum. Program courses in AC provide a common core of the general knowledge and skills necessary for beginning teachers. Candidates in the special education AC program access a wide array of courses that prepare them to meet the diverse needs of students with significant cognitive disabilities.
